### CODE OF CONDUCT

All guests utilize the Eaton Area Community Center at their own risk. The Eaton Area Park & Recreation District expects reasonable and appropriate behavior from those who utilize District Facilities and participate in District Activities. The EAPRD has developed a code of conduct to ensure the safe enjoyment of all services and reserves the right to deny admission or take disciplinary action against those in violation. A violation includes but is not limited to, the use of obscene language or gestures, theft, disorderly conduct, public intoxication, sexual misconduct, indecency, harassment, failure to cooperate with EACC staff, possession of unlicensed weapons of any kind, non-compliance with established policies and procedures, an unlawful act, and any other behavior considered offensive or unacceptable.

- Responsible individuals ages 12 and older may utilize the facility per policy and guidelines.
- No food or beverages will be allowed past the lobby with the exception of bottled water and sports drinks.
- The Eaton Area Park & Recreation District reserves the right to withhold service to any patrons who refuse to follow district guidelines and code of conduct while in a District Facility or while attending or participating in any District program.
- Athletic attire, including closed-toed athletic shoes, is required in the upstairs fitness mezzanine area and gymnasium.

- Appropriate attire is required when visiting or using the EACC. Shirts, tops, and shoes are required at all times (except in the pool area). Non-marking shoes are required in the gymnasium and fitness area.
- Proper swim attire is required in the pool area, including mesh-lined trunks for males and swimsuits for females. Workout and street clothing are strictly prohibited. Slide users must wear swimsuits that are free of grommets, buttons or other materials that may damage the surface of the slide.
- Guests are strongly encouraged to bring their own lock or purchase one at the Welcome Desk. Lockers are for day use only and items left in lockers will be removed and placed in the lost and found. The EAPRD is not responsible for lost and or stolen items.
- A valid form of identification is required for equipment check out. Acceptable forms include EACC pass, school ID, library card, driver's license or other government issued ID.
- Although we encourage alternative modes of transportation to the EACC, bicycles, skateboards, and scooters are not allowed inside the facility and are not to be used recreationally on sidewalks or planters on-site.

# Policies & Information Continued

## PROGRAM/ACTIVITY REFUNDS

The Eaton Area Park & Recreation District aims to provide you with complete program satisfaction. We understand that from time to time scheduling changes and special circumstances require you to cancel or change your planned activities. In an effort to maximize space in each activity, we have established the following refund policies. Please review them carefully prior to enrollment. Thank you for your interest in our programs. We look forward to providing you with an enjoyable recreation experience.

## IF EAPRD CANCELS A CLASS OR PROGRAM

Full refunds are made for any program/activity canceled by the District before the starting date. A refund request form will be sent asking how you would like to receive your refund; and all refunds will be provided within 2-4 weeks of the class cancellation. Please note: Refunds for class cancellations due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances will be handled on a case-by-case basis and may include class credits, coupons, class extensions, etc.

## IF THE CUSTOMER WITHDRAWS FROM A CLASS

If you need to withdraw from a class, please let us know as soon as possible. This will allow an additional space for someone else to register or cancel the class.

## REFUNDS WILL BE PROVIDED BASED ON THESE SITUATIONS:

- **Cancellation request is made prior to the registration deadline (7 days for swim lessons, 24 hours prior to scheduled session for PT, or for day trips) to the activity/program start date.**
  - Full refund/credit will be provided to the payers ActiveNet account.
- **Cancellation request is made after the registration deadline but prior to the first meeting date for the activity/program.**
  - 50% refund/credit will be provided to the payers ActiveNet account.
- **Cancellation request is made after the activity/program start date.**
  - No refunds or credits will be provided.
  - Prorated refunds will be provided after the start of a program if participant is unable to attend due to an unplanned medical or life event.

## ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

- A 5% transaction fee will be applied when refunding back to a credit card.
- A 10% transaction fee will be applied when payer requests a refund by check.
- The EAPRD is unable to provide cash refunds. For programs/activities purchased in cash a refund to the payers ActiveNet account or check will be provided.

- Refunds/credits are not given for uniforms, jerseys, or other merchandise that have already been given to the program participant or specifically ordered for him/her.
- Participants enrolled in a trip canceled due to weather, low enrollment or other circumstances will be provided a credit to the ActiveNet account.
- Please note that not all classes are eligible for refunds.
- Programs and activities costing less than \$10 are non-refundable.
- Refunds/credits placed on a payers ActiveNet account are non-refundable.
- Some programs may have specific refund policies that may require additional refund fees or earlier cancellation schedules.
- The EAPRD reserves the right to change the refund policy at any time.

## MEMBERSHIP CANCELLATION POLICY

Per our Policies and Procedures Guidelines - if you request to cancel your annual 12-month auto-pay membership, you will be required to pay an additional month. If your annual membership was paid in full, you will receive a refund for the remainder of the membership minus one month. Membership cancellations charged on autopay must be requested at least 7 days in advance of payment date. This will be credited back to your credit card on file. \* Please note we do not put memberships on hold.

### PASS INFORMATION

- Annual passes may be purchased in 12 monthly installments, or in full. Discounts are given for annual passes that are paid in full.
- All other passes must be paid in full at time of purchase.
- District discount rates apply to non-exempt residents of the Eaton Area Park & Recreation District. The EAPRD is largely made up of the Weld RE-2 School District and excludes certain areas within the Severance and Greeley city limits. Property tax is the main funding for the EAPRD, so those contributing District property taxes are eligible to receive our in-district discount rates.

- 20-punch passes may be used by more than one person. Passes expire 5 years from purchase.

## FITNESS MEZZANINE POLICY

Children under 11 years old are not allowed upstairs in the Fitness Mezzanine. Guests that are 11-14 years old will need to complete a youth orientation before being allowed upstairs; and after this guests 11-13 will need an adult 18 years and older with them at all times. Guests 15 years and older are allowed upstairs in our Fitness Mezzanine. No strollers are allowed upstairs in the Fitness Mezzanine at all, including our walking track. Guests can walk with babies in a baby carrier on the track, but are not permitted anywhere else in the Fitness Mezzanine, such as the circuit machine area, weights section, and cardio area. Guests with babies are allowed to workout downstairs in the fitness pod area in the hallway with their babies in a stroller or baby carrier away from the weights; they cannot be out of their strollers/carriers.



# General Information

## TeamSideline Information

- We strongly encourage participants to utilize the app. This platform provides coordination and updates for players, parents, and coaches, ensuring everyone stays informed and connected throughout the season.
- All EAPRD leagues will utilize an app called TeamSideline. From this app parents and coaches will be able to see their team's roster, practice schedule, picture schedule, and game schedule.
- To begin using this app, download it from the app store on your phone or device and register your information using the email associated with your EAPRD account.
- When your player is placed on a team in TeamSideline, you will receive an invitation in the email that is used for your player's account with the EACC. Once you accept the invitation, you will be able to receive all pertinent team information and schedules.
- All weather updates will be announced using TeamSideline.

## Rules, Schedules, and League Information:

A copy of league rules will be emailed to all participants. TeamSideline will house any pertinent information for the league, including updates for weather or health. Practice schedules and rosters will be posted after the registration deadline. Game schedules will be posted at the beginning of the season. Photo schedules will also be uploaded to TeamSideline.

## Combining Divisions:

The Eaton Area Park & Recreation District reserves the right to combine grade or age divisions based on the number of registrations to ensure leagues or activities will run.

## Inclement Weather Notifications:

Every attempt will be made to allow practices and games to be played; however, if weather conditions present an unsafe environment for participants, spectators, coaches, officials, and/or staff, we will postpone or cancel practices and games. Weather information can be found on TeamSideline and the EAPRD Weather Line at 970.612.6854. There are three situations to look for:

- All games and practices are being played as scheduled.
- All games and practices have been canceled.
- All games and practices will be held at the coach's discretion. In this case, please assume that practice is being held unless you hear differently from your coach.

## Youth Reversible Jerseys

For all sports and all divisions, it will be necessary to purchase a reversible red and white jersey at the Welcome Desk of the Eaton Area Community Center. We offer a sleeveless and short sleeve option for all leagues with numbers already printed on the back. Old jerseys can be brought in for a \$10 credit towards purchasing a new jersey. Recycled jerseys will be available for purchase at a discounted rate. Jersey must be deemed to be in good condition to qualify as recyclable at the discretion of the Athletics Coordinators.

## Scholarships:

Scholarships are available for eligible participants. A Scholarship Request Form must be filled out in person at the Eaton Area Community Center prior to registration. Applications must be submitted and pre-approved before registration. ## Additional Fees/Refunds/Account Credit:

- Registrations received after the deadline are subject to a \$15 fee.
- Cancellation request is made prior to the registration deadline of the activity/program start date.
  - Full refund/credit will be provided to the payers ActiveNet account.
- Cancellation request is made after the registration deadline but prior to the first meeting date for the activity/program.
  - 50% refund/credit will be provided to the payers ActiveNet account.
- Cancellation request is made after the activity/program start date.
  - No refunds or credits will be provided.
  - Prorated refunds will be provided after the start of a program if participant is unable to attend due to an unplanned medical or life event.

## Special Requests:

- One request per registration:
  - A request to practice at a specific time.
  - A request to play on the same team as a specific player. If you request more than 1 player, only the first listed will be considered.
  - Participants can "play up" an age division at parents discretion. No participant will be permitted to "play down" an age division. Once the decision to "play up" is made, players must remain in that age division for the duration of the season.
  - All leagues will no longer have the option of a coach request during the registration process. This will allow the EAPRD Staff to ensure that games are fairly matched during the season.
  - Coaches will not be permitted to submit rosters, make requests, or form teams.

*If requests for any preference exceeds the amount of roster slots, priority is given based on the registration date and time. We will attempt to honor all requests, but retain the right to deny any requests to maintain team equality. Therefore, requests are considered but not guaranteed.*

## Waiting List:

A waitlist will become available once an activity or program has become full. This list will be used to provide us with contact information in case a spot opens up and does not limit you from registering for another open sport. Being added to the waitlist does not guarantee a spot in the activity or program.

## Volunteer Coach Recruitment:

Volunteer coaches are always needed! Please contact an Athletics Coordinator at 970.454.1070 for additional information about becoming a volunteer head coach. Parents/guardians who choose to volunteer to coach their child's team will receive a 100% refund of their child's registration cost as an account credit. If the coach chooses to volunteer for two of his/her children's separate teams, he/she will receive 100% account credit for registration for each of the teams he/she is coaching. If a parent chooses to volunteer coach for one child's team but not another, he/she will only receive 100% account credit for the registration of the team he/she is coaching. Volunteer coaches who do not have participating children will receive a program credit equal to 100% of the registration fee of the league the coach is volunteering for as an account credit. One assistant coach will be issued a 50% credit from their registration. They must be approved by EAPRD staff and complete coaching documents. Account credit will not be issued until the conclusion of the season.
